The situation in the private sector is divided in three bigger blocks

- 1. Companies with their focus on industrial and engineering jobs
- 2. Companies with a focus on civil engineering with their own surveying engineers
- **3**. Companies mainly doing cadastral work

Germany has a total number of about 25.000 surveying engineers and about 25.000 surveying technicians







The situation to employ new surveying specialists

- The Companies mentioned under 2. and 3. lost about 40 % of their surveying staff during the crisis on the construction market between 1997 and 2004
- The unemployment rate for surveying engineers is about 10 % for Germany
- > The universities develop about 700 surveying engineers each year
- > There is no lack of surveying engineers in Germany nowadays
