- I'm looking for a trainee: companies offering the post



•The titles of the sections should be changed to the following:

OVACANCIES / JOB OFFERS OSTUDENT / TRAINEE CV's

- •A discussion is currently happening as to who is to upload the information i.e. If we should have an administrator or if the public themselves should upload their information
- Advantages of public upload: minimal work for administrator
- Disadvantages of public upload: no control over what is being posted and possibly creating spam



- Advantages of admin upload: control over what is being uploaded
- •Disadvantages of admin upload: work can escalate if the exchange takes off
- •So The way forward should be:
- A standard form, with standard requests
- One for the person applying for the job
- One for the Company offering the job
- •A notification will be sent to myself and JY that a form has been posted and we will check it to make sure there is no 'spam'



Form to include the following information:

Student / Trainee looking for a job

- First Name / Last Name / Contact Number
- Email address
- Nationality / Age
- Which country are you in now
- What year did you graduate
- Which University did you attend
- When can you start working
- •Which is your preferred country?



Form to include the following information:

Company offering a job:

- Company Name / Contact Name / Contact Number
- Email address / Website address
- Country / Region
- What position are you offering
- Does the applicant need to be a graduate
- Can a student apply
- What is the duration of the vacancy
- When will the vacancy be available



Problem with a contact form is that all the personal information of the student / trainee is online & visible to all!!!!
