In Reykjavik, the CLGE GA has organized a workshop about the future strategy.

This workshop was based on a brainstorming session. The results of the session, including the SWOT analysis that was conducted, were analysed by the incoming board, during its first meeting held in Villars sur Ollon (CH), 6 - 7 February 2015.

After studying the Strength, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats mentioned by the delegates, the Executive Board has acknowledged the quality of the previous Strategic plan. Indeed, many of the elements are already mentioned or announced. Hence the proposal is to stick to the major goals of the plan, as set out during the previous election period, and to introduce new accents inspired by the Reykjavik / Villars results listed below:
