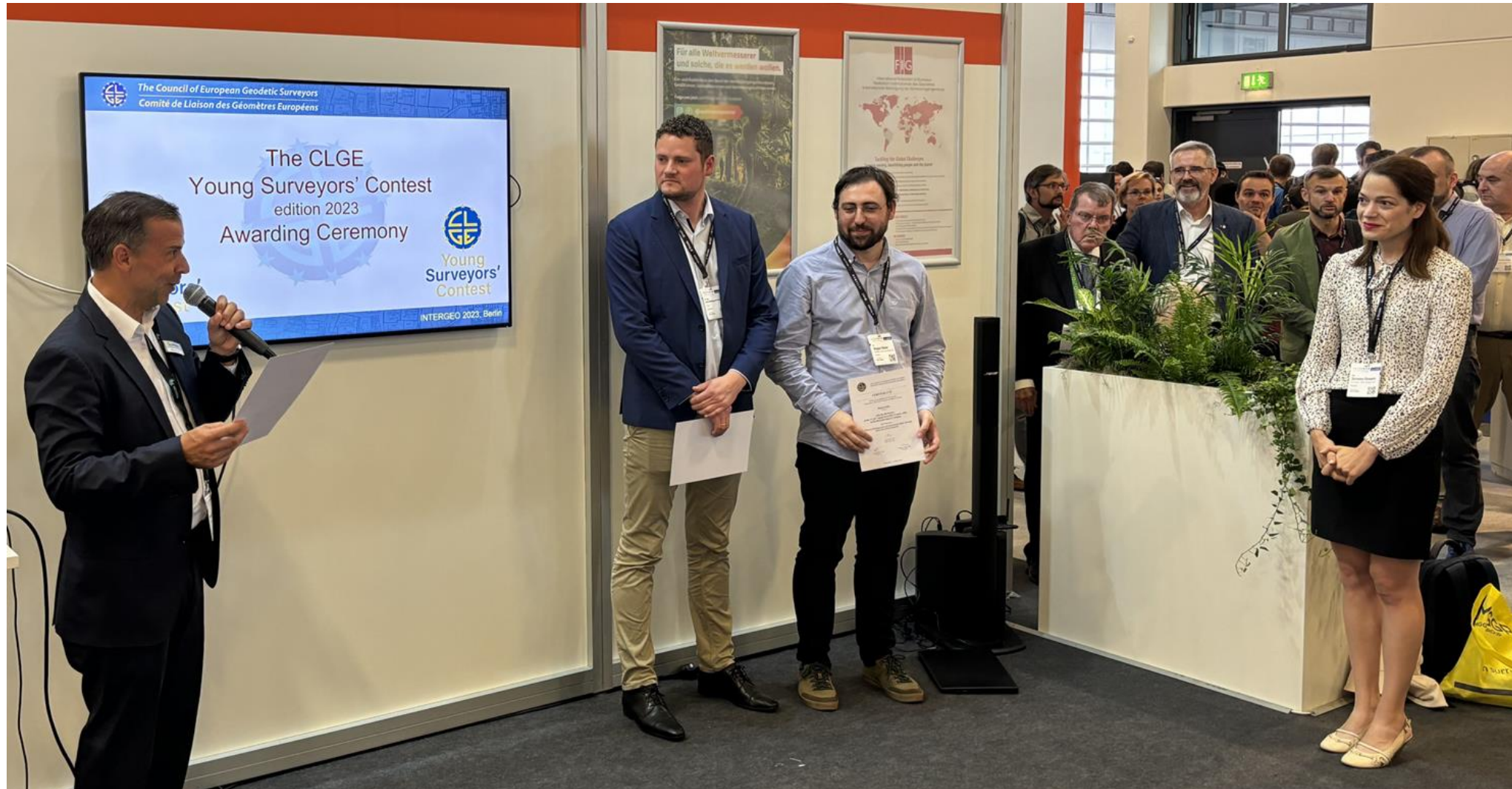

What you should do?

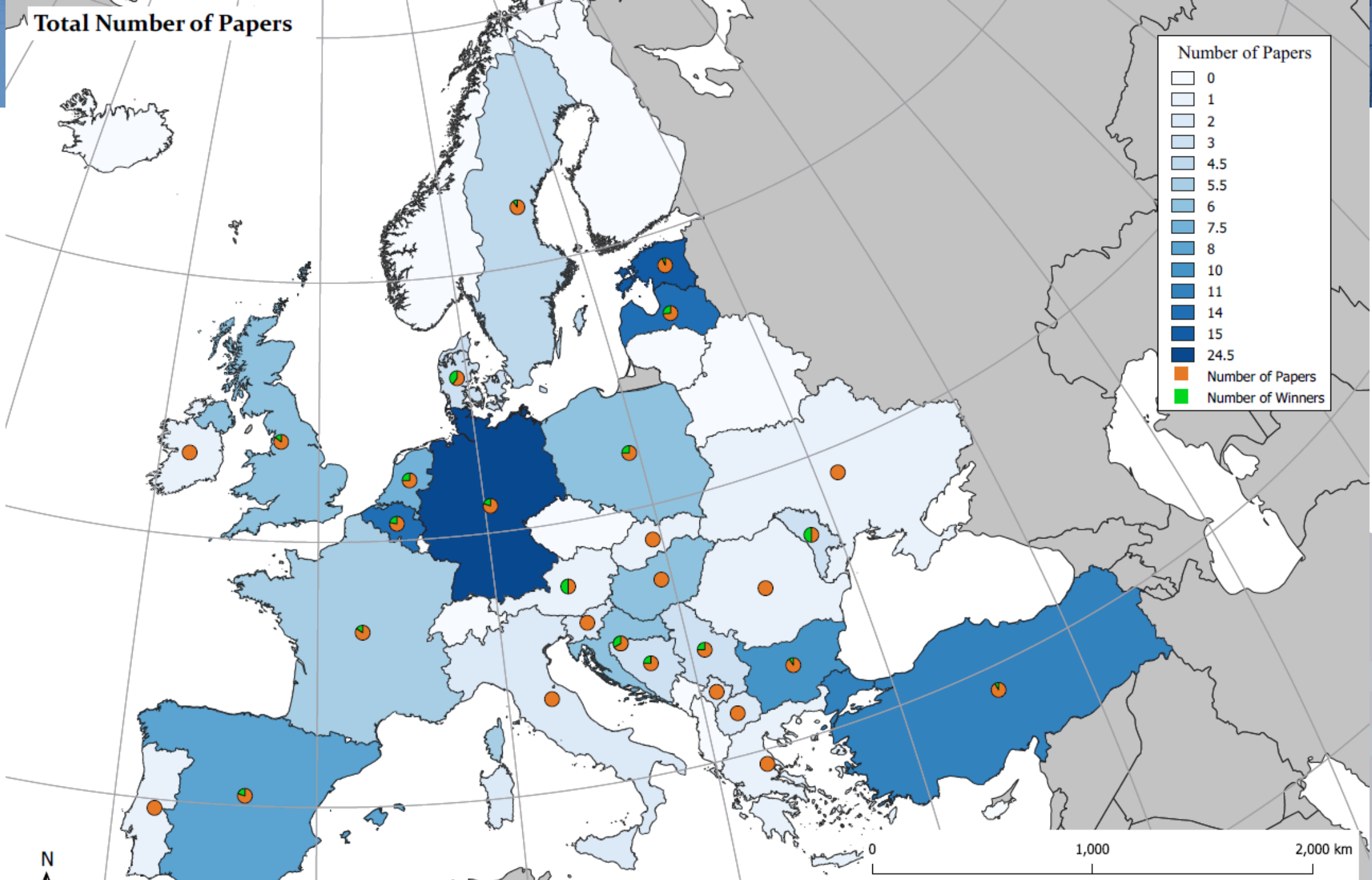

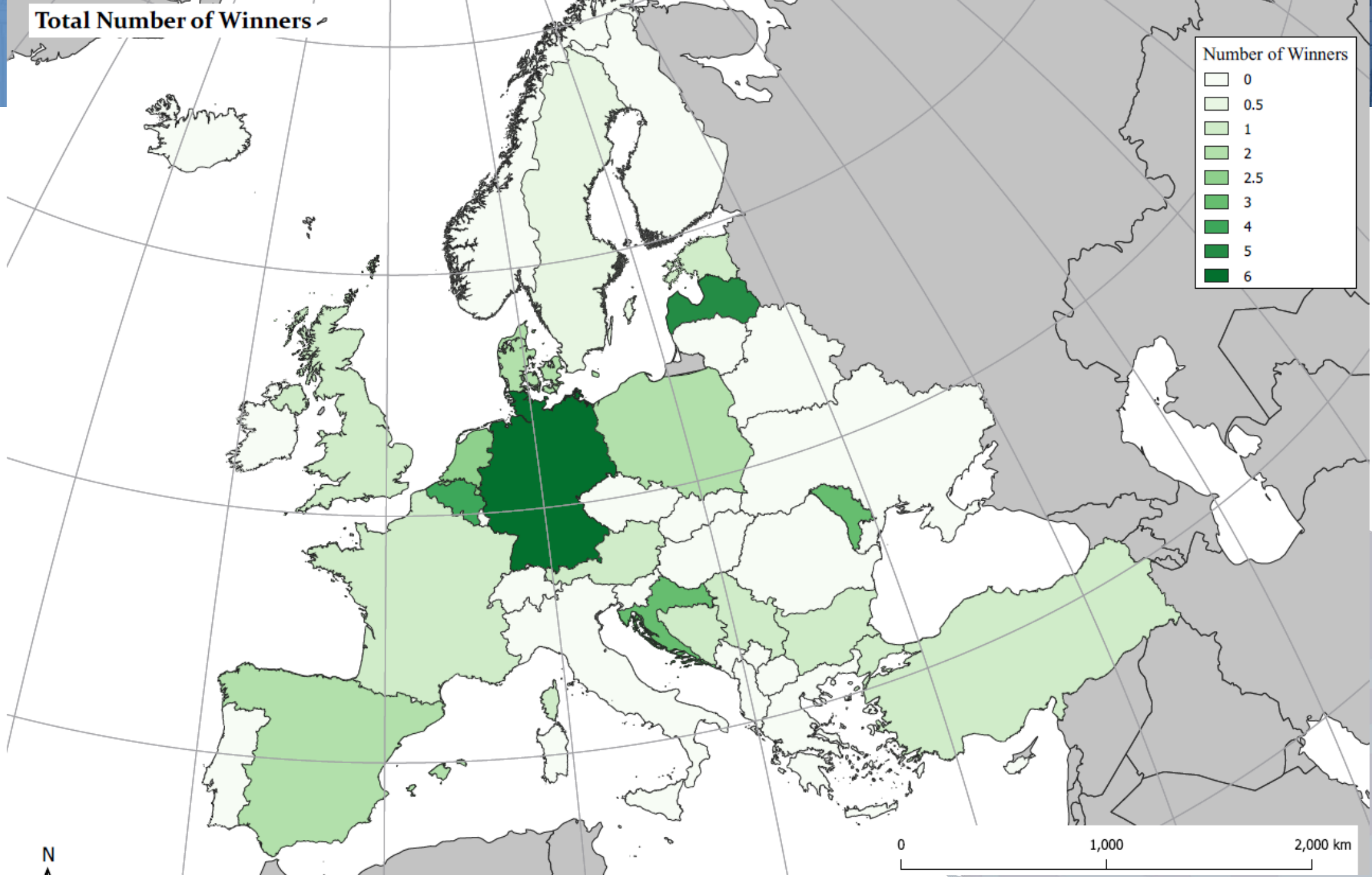
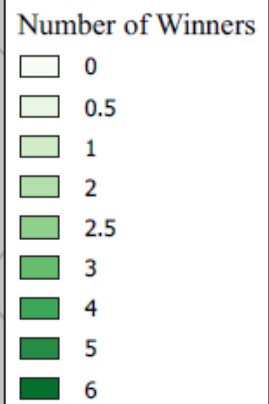


Total Number of Papers

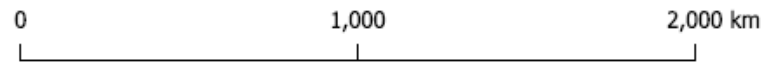
